- Hope Outreach will be using the kitchen downstairs for all its functions and activities. Hope Outreach also received permission to paint the kitchen and make any repairs. This will be funded by the Hope Outreach group.
- The youth group received permission to paint its classroom upstairs in a neutral color.
- Under direct supervision of the Kilsyth Church Trustee Board, Brother Len Thompson was appointed the role of "building & grounds maintenance worker." This is a volunteer position. His responsibilities include taking care of all church maintenance issues including snow removal and lawn care. This position is an ongoing position and will not be voted upon each year.
- Barbara Boyd and Pam Souk were appointed to be the Church's decorating committee. All church decorating will be organized and facilitated by these two ladies.
- Pastor Doug asked the Church to
