Palm Sunday

Palm Sunday is a reference to the triumphant entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem to celebrate the feast day of Passover. The story is relayed to us in John 12:12-15, where we are told that as Jesus came toward Jerusalem, the people ran out and spread palm branches along the road for him, and proclaimed, "Hosanna," that He is the King of Israel and God's Ambassador. We are then told that Jesus rode a donkey into the city of Jerusalem, which fulfilled a prophecy that the King would enter the city riding a donkey. The Bible portrays this entrance as the recognition of Jesus as King of all of mankind, and Savior to His people. The word "Hosanna" in Hebrew means "save," and is a reference, by the people, to the belief that Jesus was coming to save His people, as well as all of mankind.

"Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!"
