In this week's passage, Jacob has a dream from God about a ladder (or stairway) descending from heaven with angels going up and down. God tells Jacob that the land he is sleeping on would be given to him. Talk with your child about promises. Show him or her different examples of promises, such as your wedding ring, a purity ring of some kind, or something else. Remind him or her that we should keep our promises, just as God kept His promise to Jacob.
