

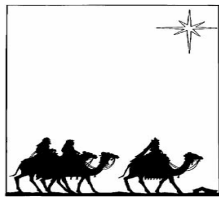
This Week's D6 Family Theme: Providence

Food Pantry

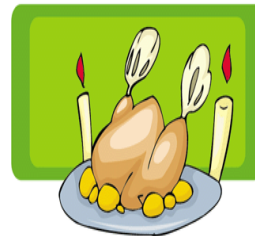
