In Exodus 20 God gives Moses the Ten Commandments. Read these as a family. Explain to your child what fearing God means (respect, reverence, worship). When we recognize who God is and what He has done for us, we won't want to keep sinning.

Plan a restoration project as a family. Pick an old chair, a cluttered room, or stained coins to restore to their previous state. Isaiah 1:18 tells us that when our sins are removed, our hearts are white as snow. Talk with your child about God's holiness-how it is perfect and how He shares it with us. Discuss how you can better follow Him.

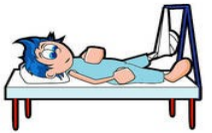
Teacher, Teacher.
