D6 family As a family, read the passage about Stephen in Acts 6:8-15. While persecution in America may not be as harsh as Stephen's, it still occurs. Ask your children if anyone has ever made fun of them because of something good they did. Talk about how we should respond to hateful remarks or discouraging people. Remind your children of the verse in Matthew instructing us to love others as ourselves (Matthew 22:39). Pray with your children, asking that God's will be done when there is persecution and that you would handle it appropriately.

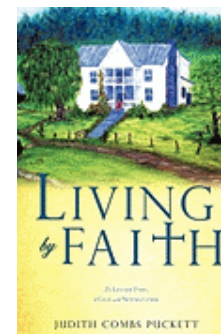
FWB Missions Golf Tourney
